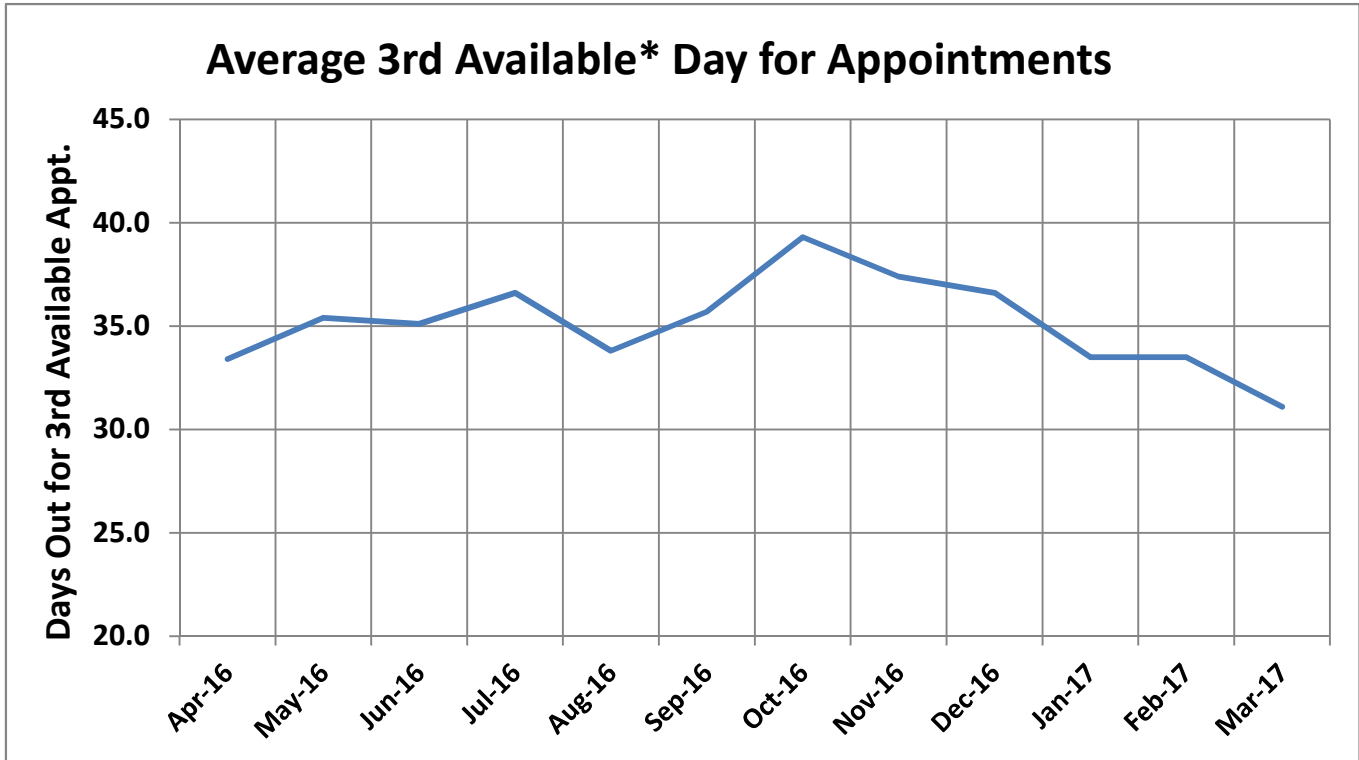

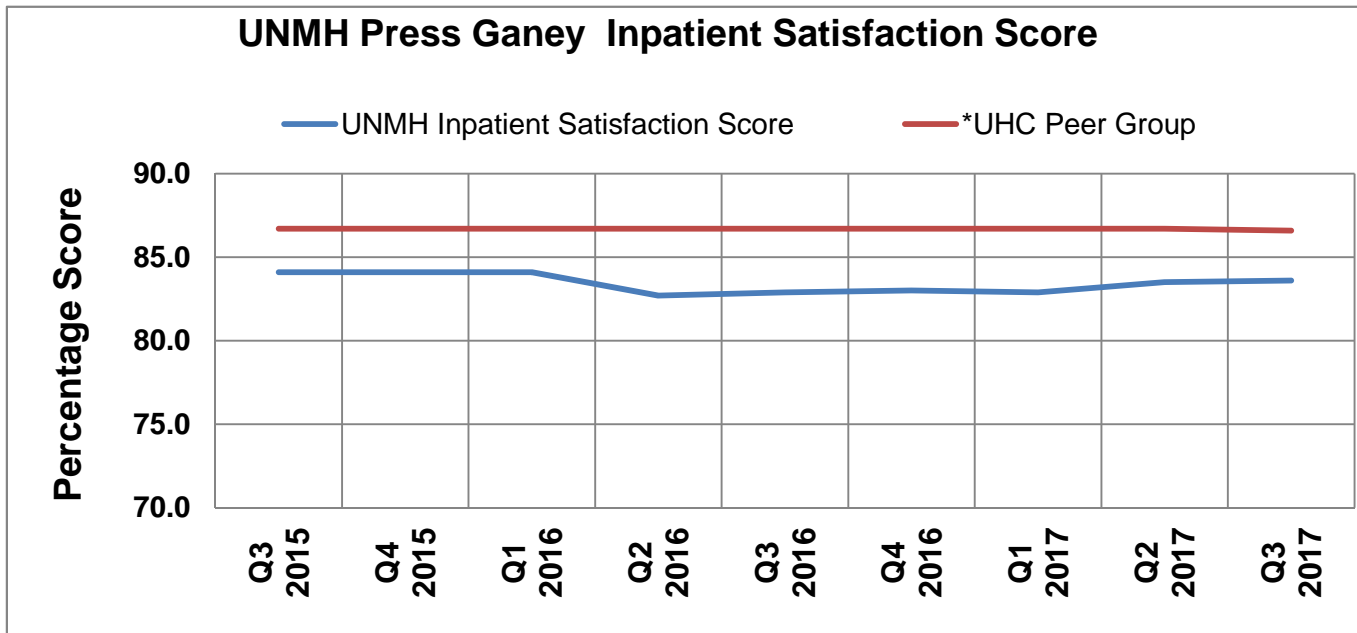

Average time for an Appointment for Primary Care


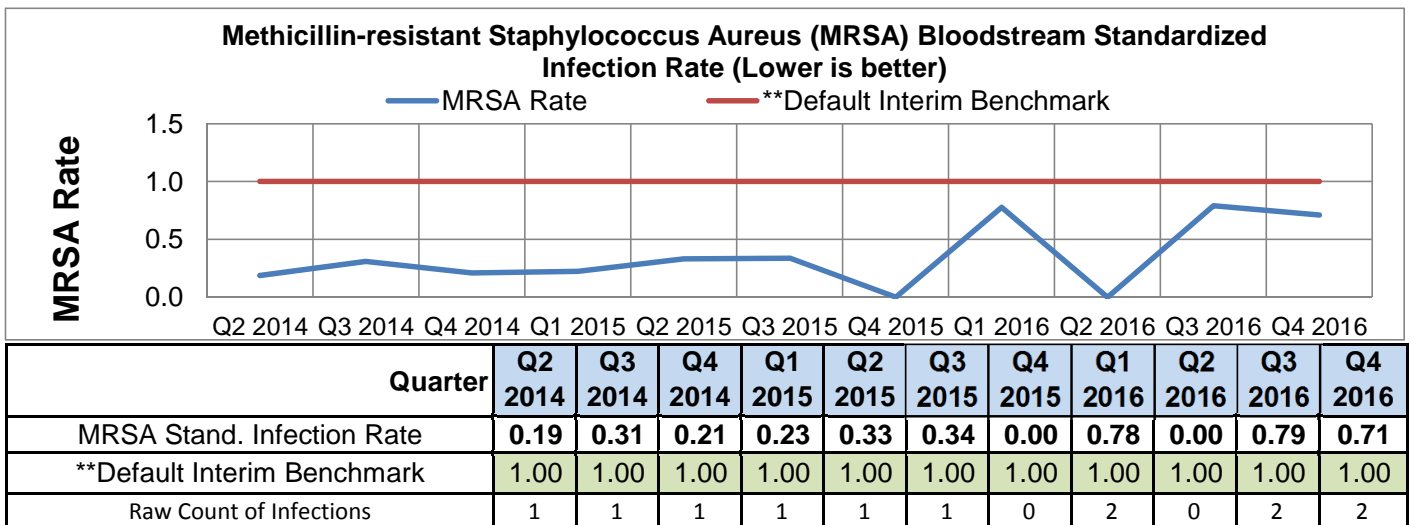
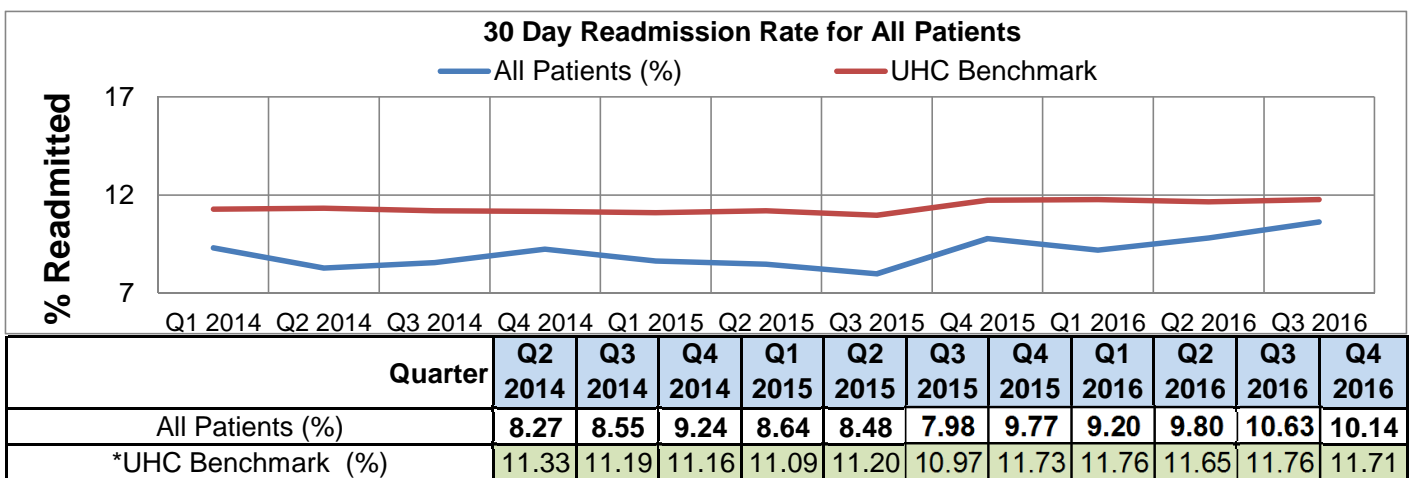
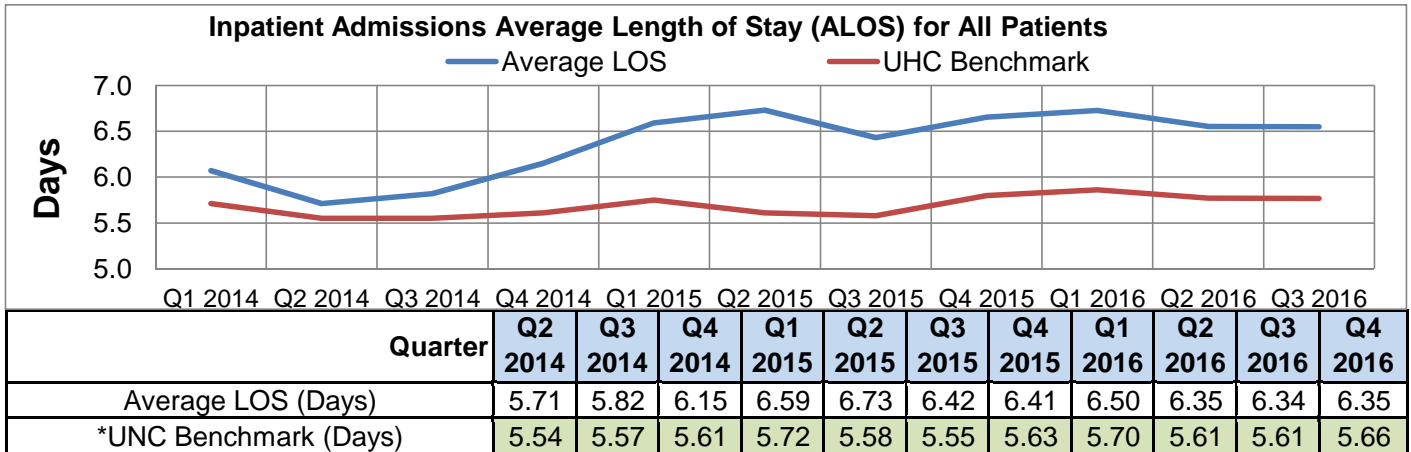

Emergency Department (ED) Visits (Not including Urgent Care)



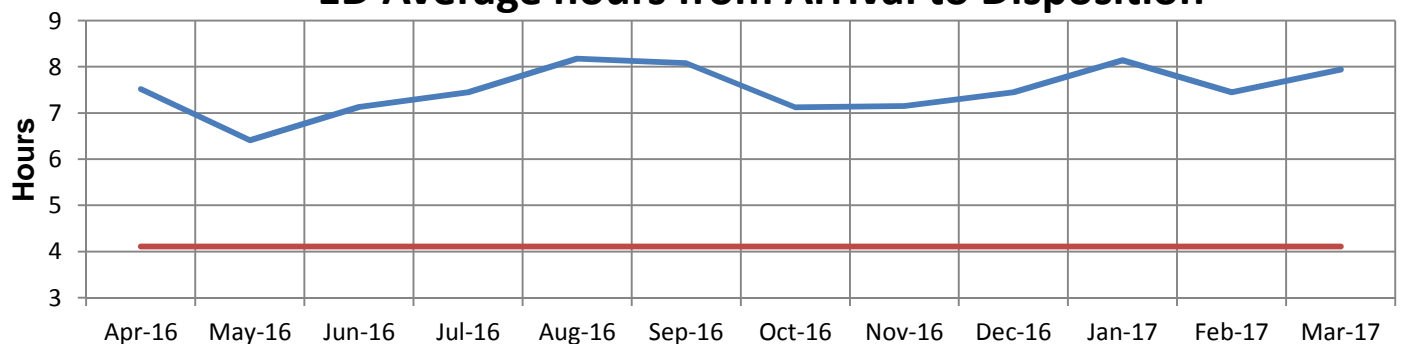

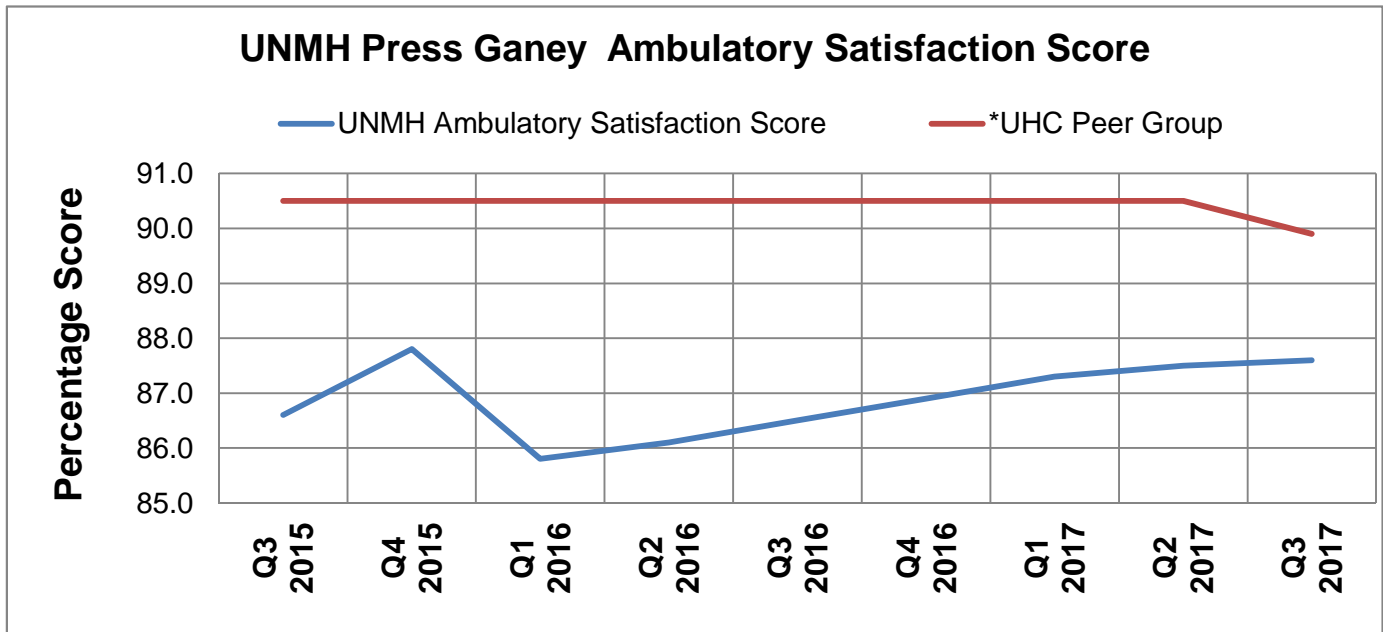

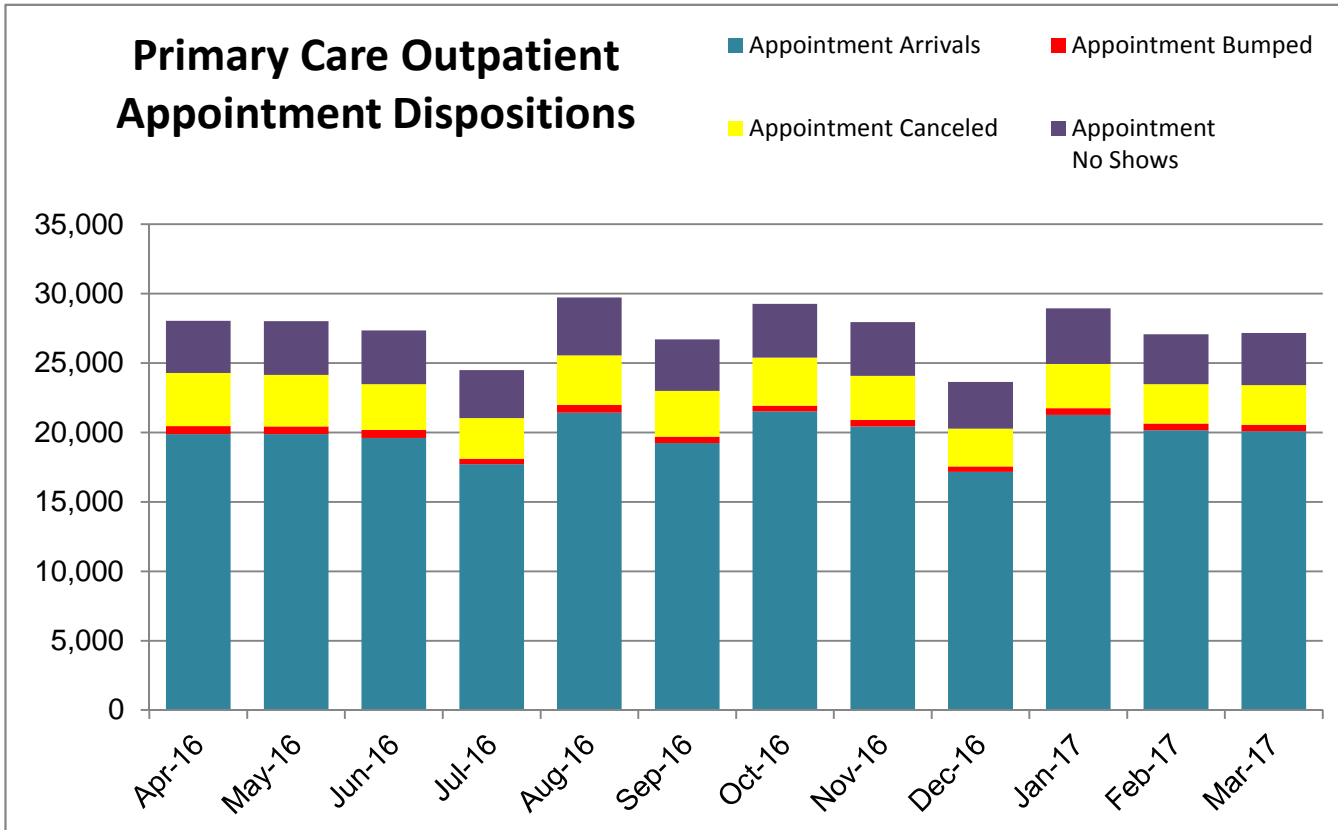

Twelve Month Same Day Access Average by Clinic

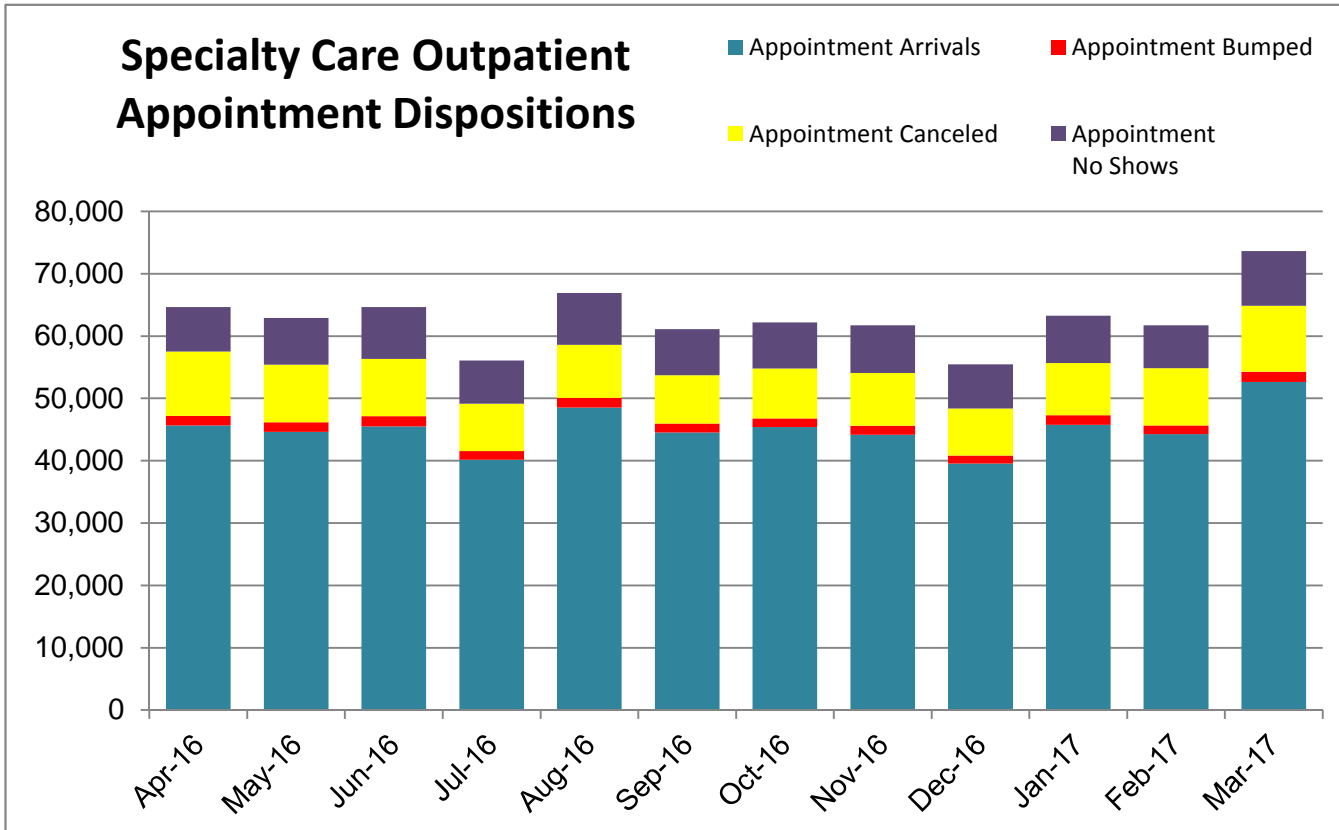

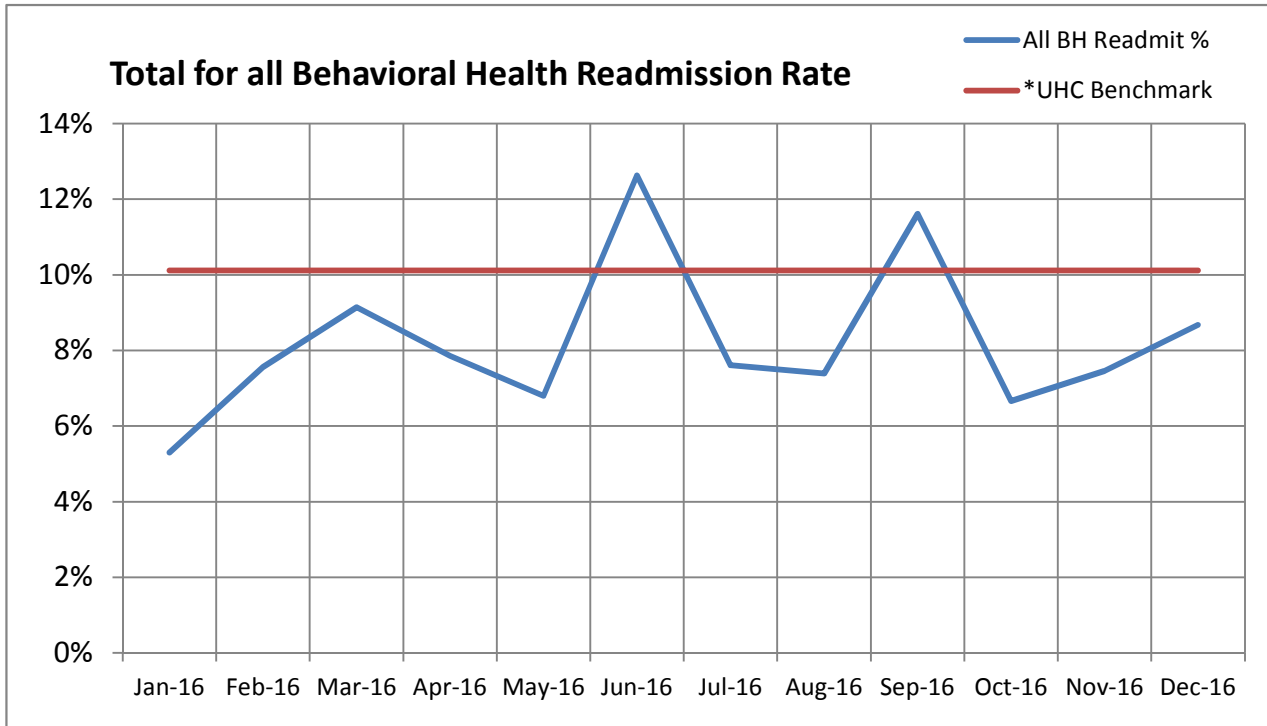

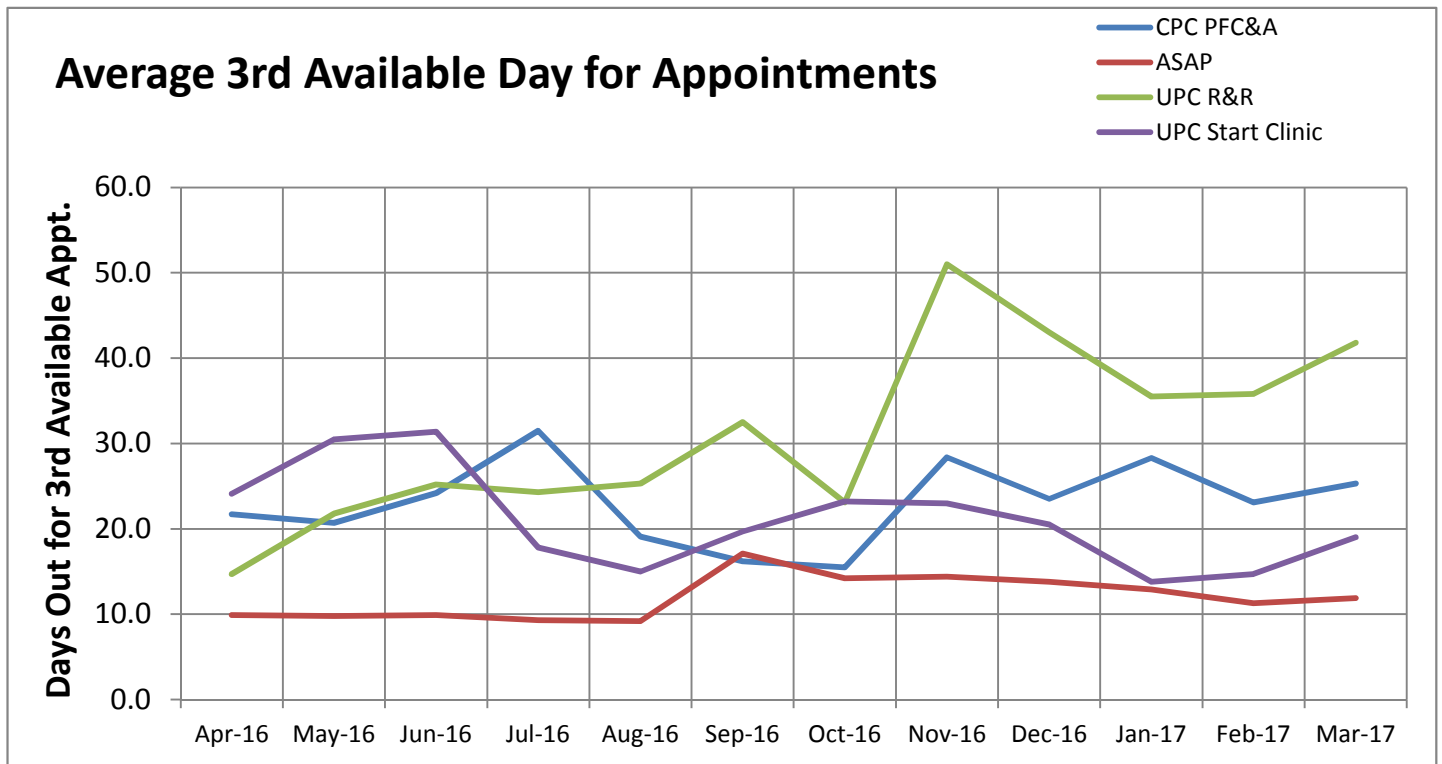
