# UNM Competency Attestation Guideline for Completion by the Credentialing/Enrollment Liaison (CEL)

The Credentialing/Enrollment Liaison (CEL) fills out the form (to the best of their knowledge) that the Provider has completed, or is scheduled to complete, the following:

Fridays 9:00 am - 10:00 am

Walk-in basis, no scheduling online, bring medical clearance from EOHS
