Important Instructions:

If you are taking any of the following medications please stop taking them for the recommended amount of day(s)/time before your procedure.

- Dabigatran (Pradaxa)
- Rivaroxaban (Xarelto)
- Apixaban (Eliquis)
- Desirudin (Iprivask)
- Aspirin or NSAID
- Aspirin and Dipyridamole (Aggrenox)
- Cilostazol (Pletal)
- Clopidogrel (Plavix)
- Ticlopidine (Ticlid)

Medical Thoracoscopy (Pleuroscopy):

If you are here for pleuroscopy, please have someone with you to stay and drive you home after your procedure. You will be under procedural sedation, which means that you will not be asleep. <u>If you do not have someone</u> with you, your procedure may be cancelled.

Please do not eat or drink after 11 p.m. the night before your procedure. Plan to be here for about 2-3 hours for your procedure.

Thoracentesis & Tunneled Pleural Catheter:

You will receive local anesthesia for your procedure. This means that the doctor will numb the area that they are working on with Lidocaine. You will be completely awake for this procedure. Plan to be here for 1-2 hours for your procedure.

Other Information:

It is important to arrive <u>at least 15 minutes before</u> your procedure. You will need to make any required copayments on the day of the procedure.
