A Night of Heroes was established to help support and celebrate the selfless life changing and lifesaving work of our first responders and health care workers at The University of New Mexico Hospital, the region's only Level I adult and pediatric trauma center serving New Mexico and the Southwest.

The facility now called UNM Hospital opened in 1954 as Bernalillo County Indian Hospital, the only hospital dedicated to serving local Native Americans. In the late 1960's, the facility became part of the University of New Mexico, and in 1979, the hospital took its current name. The primary teaching hospital connects us to highly trained medical staff that breathe life into our mission: Delivering high-quality, accessible healthcare to all New Mexicans.

The highest quality of care for more than 200,000 individuals each year. UNM Health providers specialize in over 150 areas of medicine and employ over 7,000 professionals. Together, we receive 900,000 outpatient visits, 22,000 surgical cases and 100,000 emergency room visits each year.

As New Mexico's health care leader, we have a vital responsibility to our communities focusing on health equity and access to care. Patients are not turned away based on their ability to pay; our hospital provides \$135 million in uncompensated care each year.
