When should I call?

- Someone is exhibiting behaviors that place you or someone else at risk of harming themselves or others
- Thoughts of suicide
- Severe stress that impacts daily and/or family functioning
- · When you don't know what else to do

When to call 911

- If there is a suicide attempt or if you or someone else you know is in immediate risk of attempting suicide.
- There is immediate risk of violence with a weapon
- If medical attention is needed
