The Mobile Response Team will provide **on-site behavioral health crisis intervention services** to individuals **in Bernalillo County**.

and we will:

- Respond within two (2) hours to a call where a crisis is occurring.
- Triage calls to connect individuals with care and services.

We help with:

- Safety planning
- Supportive crisis counseling
- Referrals to community resources
- Coordination with community partners, as indicated

When should I call?

- Someone is exhibiting behaviors that place you or someone else at risk of harming themselves or others
- Thoughts of suicide
- Severe stress that impacts daily and/or family functioning
- When you don't know what else to do

When to call 911

- If there is a **suicide attempt** or if you or someone else you know is in immediate risk of attempting suicide.
- There is **immediate risk of violence with a weapon**
- If **medical attention** is needed
