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World Cerebral Palsy Day October 6, 2024

World Cerebral Palsy Day (October 6) is celebrated annually to raise awareness about CP.



Founded in 2012 by the Cerebral Alliance, World Cerebral Palsy Day brings global awareness to the issues facing people with Cerebral Palsy (CP) and fostering a world where individuals with CP have equal rights, access and opportunities in society. There are 17 million people worldwide with CP. CP is usually noted in infancy or early childhood.

It is caused by “damage to, or abnormalities inside, the developing brain that disrupt the brain’s ability to control movement and maintain posture and balance.” **For more information and resources, click here: [Resources](#).**

StationMD is a telemedicine service now available to **all** individuals who are on the **Medically Fragile Waiver or Mi Via**.

Telehealth for Individuals with IDD on the Mi Via & Medically Fragile Waivers

The Developmental Disabilities Supports Division (DDSD) of the Health Care Authority (HCA) is now partnering with StationMD to provide telemedicine services to individuals with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities (IDD) in New Mexico. Individuals receiving home and community-based services through the Mi Via and Medically Fragile Waivers can enroll and HCA covers the cost. Anyone on the Mi Via or Medically Fragile Waiver who enrolls for StationMD is able to connect with a doctor 24/7 for any medical concern.

Who is StationMD?

StationMD is a telehealth company dedicated to serving individuals with IDD. All StationMD clinicians are board-certified and specially trained to treat individuals with IDD. Clinicians are available 24/7 via telemedicine for urgent and non-urgent medical matters. StationMD enables individuals with IDD faster access to high-quality care and improves quality of life for individuals and those who care for them.

Tips and Tricks on feeding, G-tubes, etc.

Tips and tricks from the October family Zoom on feeding, G-tubes, etc..

Repurposing non-specialty items for specialty needs -

- Using reusable, washable bags that can hang on the back of a wheelchair to keep things together
- Using separated backpack with ice in one compartment and one without to keep things organized and cold
- A bike basket can be attached to the back of the wheelchair to keep things close and to hang devices on
- Using washable pads to make bibs to protect skin, with extra pocket/layers at the bottom to catch saliva
- Using an insulated wine bag/water bottle carrier to protect feeds while out and about, like [this one](#).

Communicating with caregivers

Make a video on your phone – Record instructions, send to caregiver’s device, allows review as many times as needed

Reutilización de artículos no especializados para necesidades especializadas –

- Usar bolsas reutilizables y lavables que se puedan colgar en el respaldo de una silla de ruedas para mantener las cosas juntas
- Usar mochila separada con hielo en un compartimento y otro sin él para mantener las cosas organizadas y frías.
- Se puede colocar una cesta para bicicletas en la parte trasera de la silla de ruedas para mantener las cosas cerca y colgar dispositivos.
- Usar almohadillas lavables para hacer baberos para proteger la piel, con bolsillos/capas adicionales en la parte inferior para atrapar la saliva.
- Usar una bolsa de vino aislada o un portabotellas de agua para proteger los alimentos mientras está fuera de casa, como [this one](#).

Comunicarse con las cuidadoras

Haga un video en su teléfono: grabe instrucciones, envíelas al dispositivo del cuidador y permita revisarlas tantas veces como sea necesario.



Free COVID Test Kits

Place Your Order for Free At-Home COVID-19 Tests

As of late September 2024, residential households in the U.S. are eligible for another order of 4 free at-home tests from USPS.com.

Here's what you need to know about your order:

- Each order includes 4 individual rapid antigen COVID-19 tests ([COVIDTests.gov](#) has more details about at-home tests, including extended shelf life and updated expiration dates)
- Orders will ship free

Expiration Dates Extended

Tests may show “expired” dates on the box, but FDA has extended those dates; [see the full list of extended expiration dates](#).
